

PGF Qualifier/National Championship Rules and Regulations

Rosters:

- 1) No Roster limit
- 2) 20 player awards maximum
- 3) Final Roster deadline is July 19, 2010.
- 4) 2010 High School picture ID required at check-in. In the event an athlete is home-schooled or is in another uncommon situation, said athlete must provide a B/C, DL or picture ID; ASA or VTD cards are acceptable AND a prior year HS ID or transcript showing the athlete's grad class would have been 2010 or later or her home school documents. Coaches must show proof of ASA or VTD background check.
- 5) Regardless of age, no player who has played softball in ANY college is eligible.
- 6) If a player whose natural grad class would be 2010 or later but has advanced to college early and did not play softball in college, she is eligible. If a player is in the 2010 grad class but for some reason she is older than 18, she is eligible. In the HS Division only there is NO age limit.
- 7) If a player is on a team's roster that qualifies at a PGF qualifier she may not be on another team's roster at another Qualifier or the National Championship event in either the 18u or 16u division.
- 8) Teams will check-in at all qualifiers with correct rosters with players showing their own picture ID's at this time. Also teams must show proof of insurance at check-in.
- 9) Teams that qualify will have their rosters sent directly to the National Championship Tournament Committee by the local qualifier Tournament Director

Playing Rules:

- 1) Both the qualifiers and National Championship tournaments will be played using NFHS rules with the following exceptions.
- 2) Pitching distance will be 43' for both divisions.
- 3) Both feet must be in contact with pitching rubber prior to forward stride.
- 4) If ejected a coach must sit out next game.
